1. Module Overview

1.1 Summary

The DbExporter module is a specialized module designed to help site administrators when working with data in the database allowing for SQL query data to be exported to CSV or XML. Functionality for querying is similar to that of the built in Host "SQL" module, however, scripts are limited to be SQL Selects for security.

1.2 Module Features

- Works with DotNetNuke 6.0.0 and later
- Allows users with edit permissions to use full module functionality
- Ability to get a list of all tables in the Database with one click
- Ability to export query results to CSV or XML format.

1.3 Dependencies

1.3.1 Minimum DNN Version

DNN Version 6.0.0 and Later

1.3.2 Other Dependencies

SQL Server 2005 is required for the "View All Tables" functionality


2. Module Installation

This module installs like all DotNetNuke modules, with no special installation or configuration needed.

3. Module Usage

3.1 Overview

To use the module you start as you would with any other module, select "Database Exporter" from the list of modules and add it to a page. You will see a view similar to the following.




3.2 Module Settings


At this time no configurations exist for the module, permission to use the module is controlled by "Edit" permissions for the module instance.

3.3 Module Usage and Errors

This module allows you to execute any "Select" query against the current DotNetNuke database, your query must start with "Select", if not you will receive the following error.



In addition to this, any query that results with an error will show the respective error as sent by SQL Server. Below is an example.



You may select "Export to CSV" or "Export to XML" to download the results, or modify your query and re-execute.

4. Security Notes

Given the nature of this module, by default it is limited to work only for user that have "Edit" permission for the module instance. However, careful consideration should be taken when installing this module and making it available for other administrators on the site.

Considerations are taken by IowaComputerGurus to ensure that the module only allows SELECT statements, however, our checks are not 100% complete in protecting from a malicious user. The same concern for security should be taken with this module as is taken with the core SQL module.
